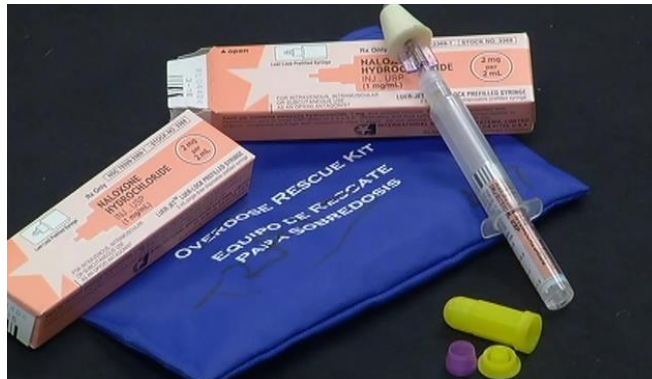


## Local Naloxone (Narcan) Distribution and Training Centers



### What is Naloxone?

Naloxone is a medication that can reverse an overdose. If someone is overdosing from opioids, heroin or prescription painkillers, this interrupts the overdose until they can get medical help.

### Where can you get a Naloxone kit and training on how to use it?

Staten Islanders can get this life-saving medication at a local organization (for free) and participating pharmacies including Duane Reade, Walgreens, Rite Aid and CVS (for a fee).
